

RESPONSIBILITIES AT PRINCE PHILIP PARK AND BEYOND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q) Who is responsible for the new town centre stores?

The Whitehill & Bordon Regeneration Company are working with Urban Regen to clear the area around the former parade square ready for build. We will also be working with East Hants District Council and a commercial agent to fill the stores.

Q) Who is responsible for the new Mill Chase Academy school construction?

Kier are building the school, managed by Hampshire County Council.

Q) Who is responsible for the relief road?

Skanska are building a section of the relief road since Carillion ceased trading. Hampshire County Council are managing Skanska, and retendering the remainder of the relief road.

Q) Who is responsible for the skatepark on Budds Lane?

The skatepark is managed by Whitehill Town Council.

Q) Who manages Hogmoor Inclosure?

The Whitehill & Bordon Regeneration Company oversee Hogmoor Inclosure including the SANG buildings. Deadwater Valley Trust are currently managing the greenspace for us and a local landscaping company are keeping the play area tidy.

RESPONSIBILITIES AT PRINCE PHILIP PARK AND BEYOND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q) Who is responsible for Bordon and Oakhanger Sports Club (BOSC)

The Whitehill & Bordon Regeneration Company will be operating BOSC from Autumn 2018.

Q) Who is building the first new homes at Prince Philip Park?

Taylor Wimpey with Dorchester Regeneration are building the first 172 new homes located on the relief road. This new development will be called Dukes Quarter.

Q) Who is building on Station Road (former Havannah Officers Mess area)

Zero C (part of Places for People) will be building 3, 4 and 5 bedroom homes in this area.

Q) Who manages the Future Skills Centre?

This is part of the Basingstoke College of Technology, with a Bordon Campus specialising in learning construction skills.

Q) Who is managing the Whitehill & Bordon Community Trust?

The Trust is made up of a team of trustees and a manager. They are working closely with The Whitehill & Bordon Regeneration Company.

Q) Who is managing Mustangs on Budds Lane?

The Whitehill & Bordon Community Trust are managing Mustangs building.

Q) Who is building new homes on the former Quebec Barracks?

Radian Homes are building homes in this area.

Q) Who is building homes on the former Louisburg Barracks?

Barratt Homes and David Wilson Homes are building in this area.

Q) Who is responsible for the new energy building in the future town centre?

The Whitehill & Bordon Regeneration Company are responsible for the new energy centre.

Q) Who is responsible for the future Makers Market in the new town centre?

The Whitehill & Bordon Regeneration Company are responsible for the Makers Market construction.

Q) Who is managing Signal at Martinique House?

Signal is being run by the Bordon Business Hub.

Q) Who is managing the new leisure centre build in the future town centre?

East Hants District Council will be managing construction for the new leisure centre.

Q) Who is managing the new medical centre in the future town centre?

WBRC will be managing the construction of the new medical centre. The services will be set out and managed by CCG. The existing Chase Community Hospital won't be moving to the new town centre.

Q) Who looks after The Bordon Enterprise Park on Budds Lane?

The Whitehill & Bordon Regeneration Company oversee the tenants and buildings in the Bordon Enterprise Park.

Q) Who are the security team at Prince Philip Park?

AIB (All in Black) are the security team looking after Prince Philip Park.

Q) Who is responsible for the Forest Community Centre?

This is managed by Whitehill & Bordon Community Association.

Q) Will the library be moving to the new town centre?

There are no plans to move the library to the new town centre.
