

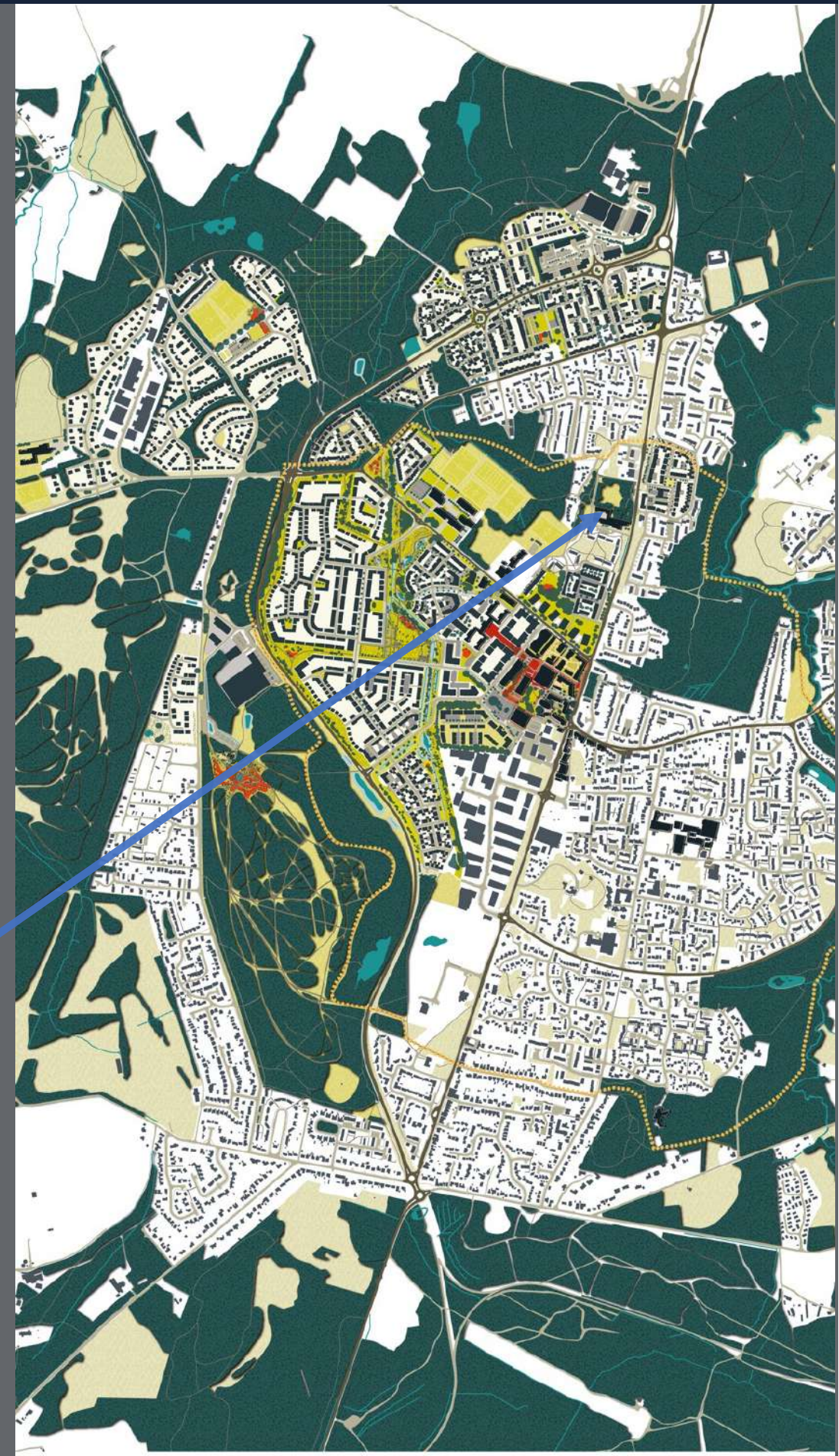


PRINCE PHILIP PARK



In April 2015 outline planning was granted for:

- **2,400 new homes**
- New Town Centre of retail / leisure space
- New Leisure Centre
- New secondary school and extended primary school
- Extensive areas of public open space, play areas and 54 ha of SANG
- Relief Road and Link Road



One job created for every new home built, and build a **new Town Centre**

Housing – create affordable, balanced and sustainable communities

Care of the environment

Community Building Social Value – investment of £54.0M through s106 agreement, £50.0M from Government and £20.5M of direct investment in community assets, schools, parks and leisure spaces

Risk Management – anticipation of market cycles and managing challenges/ problems faced

Innovation – fibre to the home/ 5G/ VOCA transport service

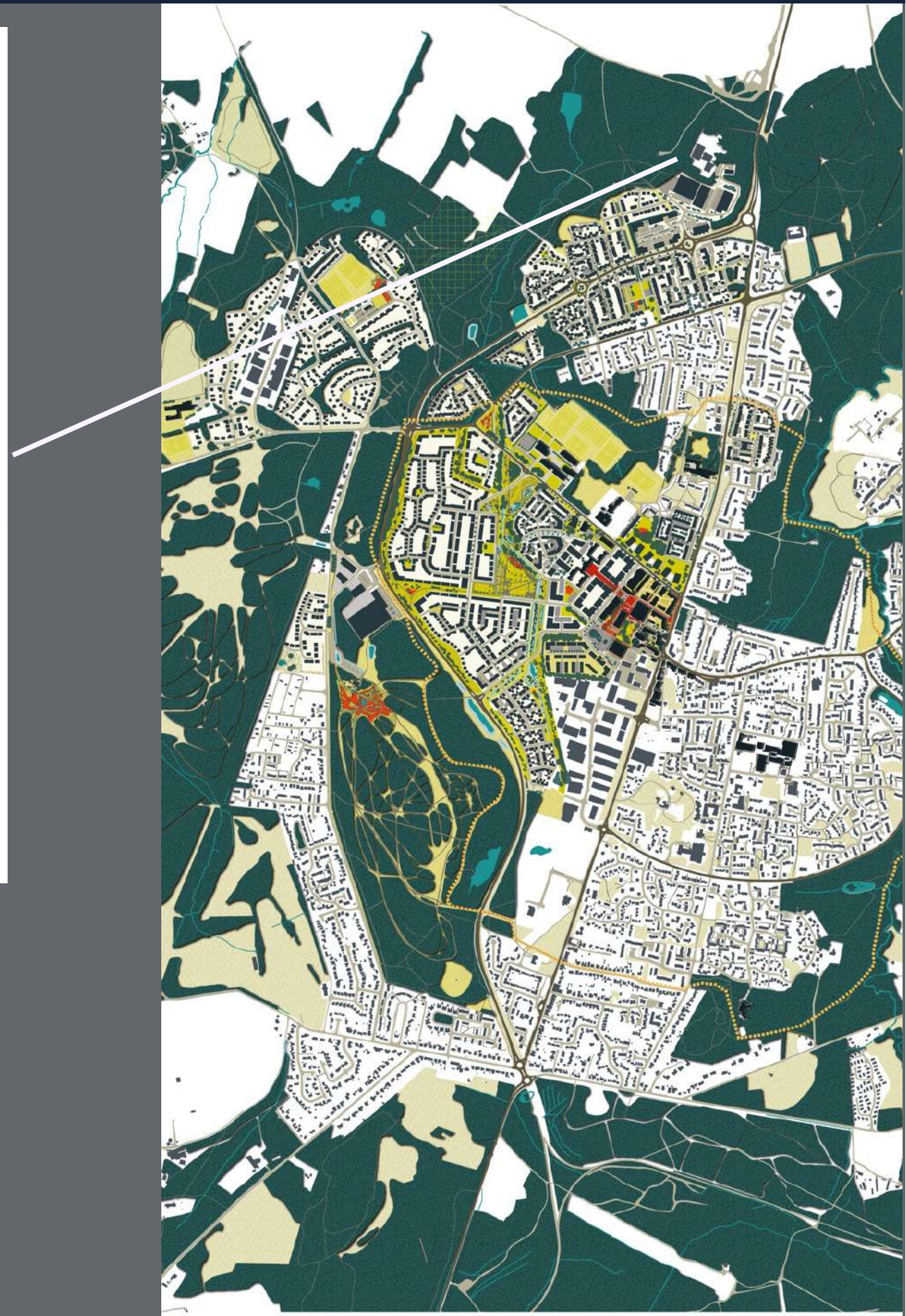
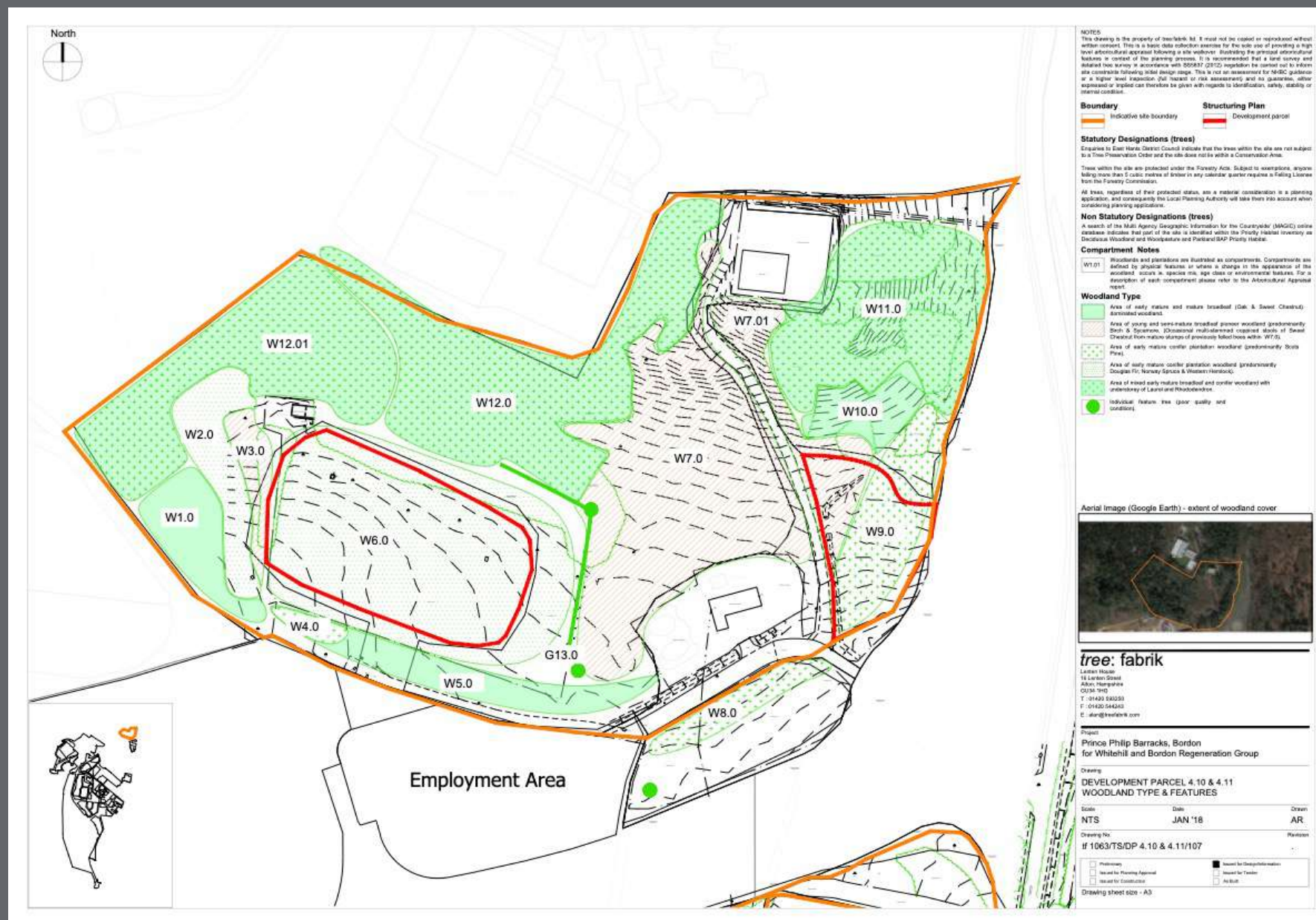


Start ups – over 80 businesses supported

Bordon Enterprise Park – more than 30 businesses supporting more than 435 jobs

Apprenticeships – more than 40 apprentices supported to date in the town

Town Centre – more than 100 jobs at the Shed (up by 30 jobs) and Leisure Centre, with 650 more to come once the town centre venues open



Up to 300,000 square feet of employment space feasible
